THURSDAY - All year long

MADRID · SALAMANCA · PORTUGAL

Day 1 (Thursday) MADRID

Arrival at the Barajas airport. Assistance and transfer to the hotel. Accommodation. Rest of the day free.

Day 2 (Friday) MADRID

Breakfast and accommodation. In the morning, panoramic sightseeing: Plaza de España, Ciudad Universitaria (University City), Parque del Oeste, Casa de Campo, Barrio de la Moreria, Plaza de Oriente (Oriente Square), Plaza Mayor, Puerta del Sol, Neptuno, Atocha, Puerta de Alcalá, the stately Retiro Park, Las Ventas Bullring, Plaza de Colón, Paseo de la Castellana, Santiago Bernabeu Stadium, Cibeles Square and Gran Via. Afternoon at leisure to explore the city or you may like to join an optional excursion to Toledo or El Escorial.

Day 3 (Saturday) MADRID - AVILA - SALAMANCA

Breakfast. Departure towards Avila, World Heritage Site and the birthplace of St. Teresa of Jesus. Its great Romanesque wall surrounds the city and hosts most of its monumental treasure. Free time to enjoy this jewel of the Middle Ages. Continue towards Salamanca, quintessential college town, known worldwide for it and for its artistic richness: cathedrals, palaces, churches of several styles. In the afternoon, sightseeing tour including the Plaza Mayor, Casa de las Conchas, the New Cathedral, the Old Cathedral and the University. In the evening enjoy the lively atmosphere of this city. Overnight.

Day 4 (Sunday) SALAMANCA - C.RODRIGO - COÍMBRA - FÁTIMA

Breakfast. Travel via Ciudad Rodrigo, brief walking tour of this beautiful medieval town declared a Historical-Artistic Complex, where its walls enclose a rich heritage of civil and religious buildings headed by its cathedral and castle and then, drive to the Portuguese border and continue via Guarda to reach Coimbra, site of one of the oldest universities in Europe and the former capital of Portugal, with narrow streets, "hanging houses", palaces, chapels and churches that make this city a treat for the eyes. Continue to Fatima, one of the most important Marian shrines in the world after six apparitions of the Virgin Mary to three shepherd children near Cova da Iria (Irene's Cove). Overnight.

Day 5 (Monday) FATIMA - OBIDOS - LISBON

Breakfast and departure to the beautiful medieval town of Obidos, with its nice little cobbled streets and quaint red-roofed white houses, sheltered by the impressive city walls. Our next stop is Lisbon, capital of Portugal located at the mouth of the Tagus River. Overnight.

Day 6 (Tuesday) LISBON

Accommodation and breakfast. In the morning, panoramic sightseeing takes you to the Alfama Quarter, Belem Tower and Jeronimo's Monastery. Afternoon by yourself to enjoy the city or take an optional excursion to the beautiful towns of Sintra, Cascais and Estoril.

Day 7 (Wednesday) LISBON - CÁCERES - MADRID

Breakfast. Departure to the Spanish border to reach Cáceres. Visit this World Heritage Site city. Its Almohads walls and buildings of immense historical and architectural value make this villa a portrait of the fourteenth to sixteenth centuries, as clearly demonstrate their houses, palaces and religious buildings.

The city is declared the third largest monumental site in Europe". You will see the Plaza Mayor and the old town with its medieval quarter. Then, continue the journey to Madrid. Overnight.

Day 8 (Thursday) MADRID

Breakfast. END OF TOUR.

Day 7 (Wednesday) LISBON – CÁCERES – SEVILLE

Breakfast. Departure to the Spanish border to reach Cáceres. Visit this World Heritage Site city. Its Almohads walls and buildings of immense historical and architectural value make this villa a portrait of the fourteenth to sixteenth centuries, as clearly demonstrate their houses, palaces and religious buildings. The city is declared the third largest monumental site in Europe". You will see the Plaza Mayor and the old town with its medieval quarter. Then, continue the journey to Seville. Overnight.

Day 8 (Thursday) SEVILLE

Breakfast and accommodation. In the morning, during the panoramic tour you will see: the University, Maria Luisa Park, America Square, the magnificent Pavilions of the 1929 Ibero-American Exposition, the Gardens of Murillo, and then, immediately begin a walking tour of the Santa Cruz Quarter, until reach the Cathedral (visit inside) with the Giralda, once the minaret of the mosque and today the belfry. Afternoon at leisure to explore the city and its traditional quarters.

Day 9 (Friday) SEVILLE - RONDA - COSTA DEL SOL

Breakfast and departure. We will take the scenic Route of the White Villages to reach Ronda, one of the oldest cities in Spain, whose origins date back to the Neolithic. Free time to admire the most important monuments such as the Plaza de Toros (Bullring), symbol and soul of the city, and the Puente Nuevo (New Bridge), from where we enjoy spectacular views. In the afternoon, drive to the world famous Costa del Sol. Dinner and overnight.

Day 10 (Saturday) COSTA DEL SOL - GRANADA

Breakfast and free time in this world famous tourist destination. Mid-morning departure to Granada which is located at the foot of the Sierra Nevada mountains. Visit the remarkable Alhambra, a palace and fortress complex declared a World Heritage Site, with its wonderful Nasrid Palaces and the gardens of the Generalife. Overnight.

Day 11 (Sunday) GRANADA - TOLEDO - MADRID

Breakfast and departure to Toledo. Take a tour of this monumental city, a World Heritage Site. Panoramic sightseeing and then a walking tour of the old town, visiting the Cathedral (inside visit), Church of Santo Tomé, which houses the painting widely regarded as a masterpiece of El Greco, "The Burial of Count Orgaz", and then in the old Jewish Quarter, you will see the Synagogue of Santa Maria la Blanca. In the afternoon, departure to Madrid. Overnight.

Day 12 (Monday) MADRID

Breakfast. END OF TOUR.
